

Facebook Creation Directions

1. Set background color to gray

- Format
- Background
- Choose the gray color that you feel fits best



2. Add a textbox at the bottom to site your sources as you go.

- Type in "Sources"

3. Create Facebook Bar across top

- Search a facebook logo (using search.creativecommons.org)
 - Select Google Images and then your search keyword
 - Site Your Source
- Add a rounded edge rectangle using auto shapes
- Fill it white and change the line style to white
- Type your name in the box (insert text box)
 - Font Type: Calibri
 - Adjust the font size

4. Add Header and Profile Picture

- Insert a photo
 - Upload your wordle
- Crop the wordle so that it fits across the top of the page
 - Size: 2" height by 6.693" width
- Format the picture
 - Add a border (thin black)
- Insert another photo
 - Go back to faceyourmanga.com
 - Login:
 - Username: aholst
 - Password: students
 - Use the Snip-it tool to take a screen shot of the avatar
 - Save the screen shot to your drive or desktop
- Upload the Avatar
 - Format the photo
 - Add a thin dark gray border
 - Resize the image to be 1.5" width and 1.5" length



5. Add the “status” bar

- Search a **status bar** using search.creativecommons.org
 - Choose one and copy the image
 - Paste the image in publisher
 - Don't forget to site your source
- Reposition and resize the status bar you selected
- Add a status** in the bar by inserting a text box
 - Should be related to your Learner profile

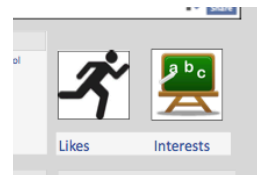
6. Add your personal information section

- Search facebook icons to use using www.search.creativecommons.org
 - Choose an image that has something to show;
 - School
 - Grade Level
 - Where you are from
 - When you were born
- Paste your image in publisher
 - Don't forget to site your sources
- Create a rectangular shape
 - Set the color a shade darker than white
- Create a second rectangle for the “About” header
 - Set the color a light shade of gray
 - Type in “about”
- Add the icons to your about (required; school, grade, where from, birthday)
 - Resize and reposition each icon
- Add a text box to add the required information



7. Add your likes and interests

- Using search.creativecommons.org find an icon for two of your likes or interests
 - You can choose a sport, hobby, book, music, etc.
 - If you want to add more, add a two in one box
- Copy and paste the images to your project
 - Resize and reposition them so they fit within your layout
 - Add a textbox underneath with the words “likes/interests”
 - Recolor the font to blue and the background to a light gray



8. Free Choice: Add either “Teacher” or “Dialogue” section
